

# 1. Precautions

### ◆ Electrical safety

Conform to country and local electrical safety standard when using or installing the product.

### **♦** Transportation with care

The PTZ should be protected against extremes of pressure, vibration and humidity during storage installation and transportation.

### ◆ Installation with care

Please refer to user installation manual when installation. Do not squeezed structure parts, which may cause mechanical damage.

### ◆ Requirements to service personnel

All the service work should be done by qualified technicians.

### ◆ Do not disassemble the pan/tilt module

Do not disassemble screws or open the dome cover. There is no user serviceable part, Only qualified engineer can service the unit.

### **♦** Environment requirements

Indoor application:

Environment temperature: 0°C~+50°C

Humidity: <95%

Air pressure: 86 ~ 106Kpa

AC power supply: AC220V, 50/60Hz

### ♦ Keep the unit away from water or moisture

Do not operate the unit near a wet location.

If entered water or moisture cause malfunction of the unit, switch off the power and notify qualified engineer to service the unit. Water or moisture can damage the unit that can also expose you to dangerous electric shock.



# 2. Features

# 2.1 System Status Display on Monitor

The monitor can display the monitor number, camera title, number, date, time, status and alarm information. User can open or close the status display after entering matrix SYSTEM MENU.



- (1) Video loss: when there is no video display on monitor, the screen displays "Voff". When the video is lost, the system buzzer will send out a alarm signal to advise User.
- (2) System status display: When the system is running Tour, the screen will display "TOUR25-01", which means the system is running NO.1 with the current tour 25; when the system is running SALVO, the screen will display "SALVO 01-POS1", which means the current monitor is running No. 1 of Salvo Group 1.
- (3) Alarm display: the screen displays "ALM01", which means the monitor is running the image which is relative with NO. 1 alarm signal.
- (4) Monitor Number: display the Number of the current monitor.
- (5) Date Display: the selectable date display of system. Three formats are available: Asian format YY/MM/DD,International format DD/MM/YY & U.S. format MM/DD/YY.
- (6) Camera Port Number: the number of port connecting camera to Matrix. The number is also the camera ID number.
- (7) Monitor Title: user can edit any memerial characteres.
- (8) Time Display: the 24H time display of system.

### 2.2 Video Tour

Can switch any video of any camera, the system can save 64 groups of tour, each group of tour can set 48 input, and the camera, park time and preset of each input can be set separately.

### 2.3 Video group

Can switch several cameras in several monitors synchronously, the system can set 64 groups, each group can switch 8 cameras in 8 monitors synchronously.

### 2.4 Switch to Previous Camera

To display the video of previous camera by ID number.

### 2.5 Switch to Next Camera

To display the video of next camera by ID number.

### 2.6 Event timer

The system can set 35 timing event, which is relative with date, time and monitor. When timing event is responded, can run or stop an appointed tour at an appointed monitor.

### 2.7 Video Loss

Any video is loss while malfunction, the system will send out a buzzer alarm, if the monitor display video loss, it will show "Voff". Even there is no video input, user can edit system menu.

### 2.8 Automatic Alarm Switch

The system has 16 alarm inputs and 4 alarm outputs. When the system receives alarm signal, It will auto-start up alarm process, and switch to the presetting video, calling preset, controlling relay output, and display the alarm status information on the monitor. Camera number, preset, park time, relayaction, monitor which are relative with alarm signal can be set through menu.

### 2.9 Alarm display

When the system receives alarm signal, can switch to the appointed camera through menu or directly run the appointed system tour.

### 2.10 Alarm Clearance

There are two modes of alarm clearance: automatic clearance and manual clearance. Under manual clearance mode, when the keyboard responds the current alarm, the system will implement the actions of next alarm. Under automatic clearance mode, when the park time of the actions of current alarm is over, the system will auto-implement the actions of next alarm.

### 2.11 Lock Functions

To reinforce the safety and reliability, to prevent unauthorization keyboard to control the protective camera, the system can set lock to keyboard, monitor, camera and alarm input.

### 2.12 Communication Ports

The system provides 2 groups of RJ45 port, one 9-bin D-SUB ports to connect PC.

### 2.13 Ports and Connectors

Video Input and Output: standard BNC connectors
Looping Video Connection: two 16-pin flat cable ports.




Front panel

"STATUS": flashing light indicates that the system is running normally.


Keyboard connect with Matrix, flashing (frequency 5HZ)

The system receive external alarm signal, flashing(Frequency 10HZ)



- (1) Video inputs: 48 video input, standard BNC connectors
- (2) Video outputs: 8 video output, standard BNC connectors
- (3) Looping outputs: 16 channels video looping output, two 16-pin flat cable ports, pls refer the above picture.
- (4) Rs232 port: Connect PC, standard 9-pin D SUB port.
- (5) Alarm input: 16 alarm input, two 16-pin flat cable ports, pls refer the above picture.
- (6) Alarm output: 4 relay output, one 12-pin flat cable port, pls refer the above picture.
- (7) RS485 port (Camera): 4 BUS output, one 12 pin flat cable port, pls refer the above picture
- (8) Keyboard port(Rs422, Keyboard): Connect keyboard, one 6-pin flat cable port, pls refer the above picture.
- (9) Enthernet port (LAN): Connect enthernet keyboard(through converter), standard RJ-45 port
- (10) System extension port(RJ-45): Connect keyboard, standard RJ-45 port
- (11) Keyboard extension port(RS422): Connect keyboard, standard RJ-45, can directly provide 12V power for keyboard
- (12) Power plug: 3 plug power socket


Open the matrix, you will find a keyS1 in the main board, press S1 for 5s, the system will reset as factory default, and auto-restart




# 6.1 Video Lopping setup

Open matrix crate, there are two DIP switches on communication board: SW2, SW3 (as the picture shows)

For example: If the first video need setting looping, dial the V1N1 of DIP switch to "OFF". (Purpose: To cut off 75 ohmic resistance on circuit board); If the first video do not need setting looping, make V1N1 at "ON". (Purpose: To close 75 ohmic resistance on circuit board).





**Knowleadge**: matrix's video looping output: It's used to transport one video signal into two devices. For example: video signal is sent to matrix's looping output, then to monitors, It should set the inputed impedance of matrix video as "high impedance" and the inputed impedance of monitoras "75 ohm"

# 7. User logs in & logs out

The system can support 8 keyboards at most, also support connect 422 keyboard and ethernet keyboard at the same time. The keyboards which are connected with matrix should have different ID. 422 and ethernet connection can not be used in the keyboard at the same time.

Log in and log out are auto processed, not need operation by persons.


While each keyboard with ID enter into system, it needs inputing keyboard's passwords. The initial passwords are "000000", The super passwords of the system are "892226"

# 8. System menu program

# 8.1 Basic Operation

### 8.1 .1 Call main menu

The system enter into the inputing passwords page by calling "SHIFT+SET", input the right passwords then press "ENT", or operate joystick to select right passwords (Remark: super passwords: 892226), Move joystick to right and enter into main menu of system. As shown in the below picture



# 8.1.2 Menu and keyboard operation

### Menu and keyboard operation

**[OPEN]** when choosing pictures, it means to increase Iris.

**[CLOSE]** when choosing pictures, it means to reduce Iris

[FAR] Focus to far
[TELE] Increase zoom
[WIDE] Reduce zoom

**(TRACK+)** when choosing menu, it means increase one parameter by degrees.

**TRACK-** when choosing menu, it means reduce one parameter by degrees.

**Joystick to up**: when choosing pictures, it means camera tilt up; When choosing menu, it means to choose the former one.

**Joystick to down:** when choosing pictures, it means camera tilt down; When choosing menu, it means to choose the next one.

Joystick to left: when choosing pictures, it means camera tilt left.

**Joystick to right:** when choosing pictures, it means camera tilt right.

Press [TEEL] and [WIDE] at the same time, it means 3D joystick rotates joystick cap.

[BACK]: Back to the former menu [EXIT]: Exit to menu

[ON] : Open some setting [OFF] : Close some setting

# 8. 2 System setting

### 8.2.1 Clock Setting

Date/time setting contains date format for selecting (three optional Date format: Asia format YY/MM/DD, International format DD/MM/YY and American format MM/DD/YY), DATE, TIME and DAY.

- 1. Press the combined keys "SHIFT+SET" on the keyboard, thus enter into Pin input page, input the pin via the keyboard, then press "ENT" for system main menu. Or move the joystick up and downward to choose the right PIN then rightward move Joystick for system main menu.
- 2. Operate joystick, move the cursor to **[SYSTEM SETTING]**, right move the joystick for sub-menu.
- 3. Operate joystick up and downward, move the cursor to [CLOCK SETTING], right move the joystick for [DATE/TIME] setting, as left picture.
- 4. Operate joystick, move the cursor to 【DATE FORMAT】, Left and right move the joystick to select the items need to be modified (Only for DATE/TIME format). Up and downward operate Joystick to do the modification, right operate the Joystick to save after setting.

5. Move Joystick to **[BACK]**, right move joystick to back to former menu.

**Notice**: in Date Format setting, the second item in the clock setting sub-menu will also vary with the date format, and the time setting is fixed 24 hours.

# 8.2.2 Tour Setting

Calling the system tour means the system can display a group of Camera's image on the screen of designated monitor in sequence.

Using the tour setting menu, 64 groups tour queue can be set at most, each queue contains 48 input ports, the 【CAMERA】, 【WELL】 and 【PRESET】 of each port can be set separately.

- 1. Operate joystick, move the cursor to 【SYSTEM SETTING】, right move the joystick for sub-menu.
- 2. Operate joystick up and downward, move the cursor to **[SET SYSTEM TOURS]**, right move the joystick for tour setting, as left picture.
- 3. 【TOUR NO. SETTING】: Operate joystick, move the cursor to 【TOUR】, input Tour no. with Keyboard (01--64), downward joystick to save, the system will automatically save the current tour parameter.

**[ENT]**: Input ports (01-48), display 8 input ports per page, 6 pages intotal. **[Camera]**: Switched camera NO.(00-99), when the input no. is 00, the system will recognize it as no camera input; If the NO. is over 48, it will be recognized as virtual and invalid NO. The system will directly jump to next input port.

**[DWELL]**: The Displaying dwell time (0-99s) of the camera's image on the monitor. If the Dwell time is 0 second, system will have no action.

**[PRESET]**: the camera's Preset point (000---128) used in executing functions, when the preset point is set as? 00? it mean the camera will keep the current image.

**[TURN OVER]**: every page display 8 [ENT], 6 pages in total, when the demanded ENT is not at the current Page, Press key [PREV] [NEXT] to do the Turn over operation.

4. Move Joystick to [BACK], right move joystick to back to former menu.

# 8.2.3 System Salvos Setting

With Systems Salvos switching function, the system can call the Image of designated camera in designated cameras' group. 8 systems Salvos switching can be set at most, the Position (POS), Camera and Preset of each system Salvos can be separately set.

- 1. Operate joystick, move the cursor to **[SYSTEM SETTING]**, right move the joystick for sub-menu.
- 2.Operate joystick up and downward, move the cursor to **[SET SYSTEM SALVOS]**, right move the joystick for System Salvos NO. Setting Menu.
- **3.** System Salvos NO. Setting: Operate joystick, move the cursor to **[**SALVO**]**, input System Salvos NO. With Keyboard (01--64), downward joystick to save, the system will automatically save the current System Salvo's parameter.
- 4. Rightward Move Joystick for Systems Salvos Parameters setting area:

**POS:**The NO. Of Output Camera (For example: the set Parameter for POS 1 Means its corresponding camera: Camera1).

**CAMERA:** Called camera NO.(00-99), when the input NO. is 00 or over 48., it will be recognized as invalid NO. Without any action.

**[PRESET]**: the camera's Preset point (000---128) called in function running, when the preset point is set as? 00? it mean the camera will not move and keep the current image.

**5.**Move Joystick to [BACK], right move joystick to back to former menu.

### 8.2.4 Event Timer

Event Timer function is the function which enable the system to automatically open or stop operating designated System tour on designated date, time and monitor. With 35 sett able Event Timer at most, the responding time, week and function (Call tour or stop tour) can be set separately.

- **1.**Operate joystick, move the cursor to **[SYSTEM SETTING]**, right move the joystick for sub-menu.
- 2. Operate joystick up and downward, move the cursor to 【SET EVENT TIMERS】, right move the joystick for EVENT TIMERS NO. Set Menu.

[EVENT TIMER] : NO. Setting of Event timer (01--35)
[CLOCK] : time setting of Event timer (01--35)
[EDIT TIMER] : relative parameters setting of Event Timer
[ENABLE TIMER] : Enable function setting of Event Timer

- 3. Take NO. Setting of Event Timer as example to illuminate the operation procedure. Operate joystick up and downward, move the cursor to [EVENT TIMER], right move the joystick to set the NO. Of [EVENT TIMER], selecting from (01--35). Right move joystick to save setting after setting.
- **4.** Operate joystick up and downward, move the cursor to **[EDIT TIMER]**, right move the joystick for relative parameters Set Menu of EVENT TIMERS (as left picture).

【DAY OF WEEK】: WEEK, IN correspondence with Sunday--- Saturday 【MON】: monitor's NO.(01---08)
Operations as follows:

- 5. Up and downward Operate joystick to the crossed position of the line of MON AND WEEK, the figure in this position will twinkle, input the tour NO.(0064) with Keyboard, if the NO. is over 64, the system will recognize it as stopping operating Tour.
- 6. **[**ENABLE TIMER] function setting enable or disable the current EVENT TIMERS' function. Two options: disable current motion; enable current motion. Right move the joystick to save.

Example: As left picture, at 11:35 of Monday, the system will run the 12<sup>th</sup> Tour of NO. 1 monitor. At 11:35 of Tuesday, the system will stop running any tour. After setting, Move Joystick to 【BACK】, right move joystick to back to former menu.

# 8.2.5 Alarm Setting

This function can be set to a certain way when the system detects alarm signal, Automatically transferred out of the designated preset position to develop the camera image, and automatic control the electric relay output.

- 1.Operate joystick, Move the cursor to **[SYSTEM SETTING]** Move joystick right to next menu.
- 2.Tilt up/down joystick, move the cursor to 【SETALARM CONTACTS】, Move joystick right to enter alarm Specification setting menu, Through numeric keyboard to set the alarm input data.

ACN: Alarm Input No [01-16] (Eg: CAN 02 is correspond to 2 alarm input)

CAM: Camera No [01-48] DWL: Dwell time [00-99]

PRE: Camera preset NO., 【000-128】

AUX: Alarm Output 【0-4】

When the keyboard input 0, display "1 ON" means the No 1 output electric relay action

When the keyboard input 1, display "2 ON", means the No 2 output electric relay action

When the keyboard input 2, display "3 ON", means the No 3 output electric relay action

When the keyboard input 3, display "4 ON", means the No 4 output electric relay action

When the keyboard input 4, means no electric relay action CN :Choose connect operate:

When keyboard input 0, the screen will display "T", it means after the alarm triggered, implement the corresponding tour is corresponding with the CAM  $\,$ 

When keyboard input 1, the screen will display "N", it means after the alarm triggered, will not implement the corresponding tour, only output the CAM corresponding with the camera image signal.

Totally 2 pages ,every page can set 8 alarm output, can use PREV/NEXT to operate former or back.

3. After finish setting, move the joystick to [BACK], move joystick right to back the menu.

**Notice:** This function must at the setting menu can set the alarm date to the monitor. when the alarm signal operate, the system can display the image at the connect monitor.

# 8.2.6 Clear and Restart Setting

- 1. Through keyboard to operate "SHIFT+SET", enter the menu, Operate keyboard input the right password then click ENT to enter the system menu or Tilt up/down joystick to choose the right password, move joystick right to enter the system menu.
- 2. Operate joystick, Move the cursor to 【SYSTEM SETTING】 Move joystick right to next menu .
- 3. Tilt up/down joystick to move cursor to 【CLEAR】, Move joystick right to enter clear setting menu, Tilt up/down cursor to choose the clear items
